## Lukenya University 1<sup>st</sup> Chancellor, Mr. Harris Mule Retires: Enters Prof. Margaret Mckenna



Mr. Harris Mule, who is the Lukenya University founding chancellor has retired after serving the University with dedication and diligence. It is during his tenure that Lukenya University transitioned from operating on Letter of Interim Authority to being chartered.

### Who is Mr. Harris Mule?

**Mule, Harris Mutio** was born on December 7, 1936 in Machakos, Kenya. He has a pleasant education portfolio: University of Denver, 1959-1962, Bachelor of Science, 1963, Master of Arts. Harvard University, 1966-1967, Master of Public Administration.

He served the people of Kenya and the world in various capacities: Assistant President, Economic Planning Department, and International Fund for Agricultural Development since 1991. Economic Consultant to International Fund for Agricultural Development, Rome, 1987-1990. Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance & Planning, 1980-1986, Ministry of Planning & Development, 1978-1980, Government of Kenya.

With remarkable contributions to nation building and university education, Mr. Harris Mule was appointed the 2<sup>nd</sup> Chancellor of Kenyatta University in the Year 2003, where he served for a period of ten years, and later became the 1<sup>st</sup> Chancellor of Lukenya University from the Year 2019 until his retirement in the Year 2022.

## CONGRATULATIONS PROF. MARGARET MCKENNA!



Prof. Margaret McKenna has taken over the chancellorship of Lukenya University, following her installation. She becomes the 2<sup>nd</sup> Chancellor of the University.

Margaret A. McKenna is a lawyer and educator, and a leading expert in educational opportunity and philanthropy. She is the former president of Suffolk University and of the Walmart Foundation. McKenna is President Emeritus and Professor of Leadership at Lesley University, and led

Lesley from a small regional college to a nationally recognized university with one of the leading teacher training programs in the country. The Student Center and a Chair in Leadership and Social Change were named to recognize her contributions during her twenty-two years as president. She is also a Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government, Institute of Politics.

From 2007 to 2011, McKenna served as president of the Walmart Foundation, the largest corporate entity of its kind in the United States. In 2010, the Foundation provided over \$900 million dollars in cash and in-kind donations to nonprofit organizations.

McKenna held a previous appointment at Radcliff College, Harvard University, where she served as director of the Bunting Institute and Vice President. Before Radcliff, she worked as a civil rights attorney, eventually becoming deputy counsel in the White House and later undersecretary of the U.S. Department of Education, where she led the education transition team for President Bill Clinton.

The recipient of 10 honorary degrees, McKenna has received awards from a variety of national and regional organizations, including Meals on Wheels, Feeding America, Women's Equity Action League, Big Sister, Council of Independent Colleges, City Year and the Boston Chamber of Commerce.

## EMBRACE YOUR DREAMS: WORLD'S RENOWNED MOTIVATIONAL SPEAKER, MR. SWAMI SHUBAMRITANANDA TELLS LUKENYA UNIVERSITY

Swami Shubamritananda Puri is a motivational speaker at large, who travels world-wide. It was an honour to have Swami visit Lukenya University and speak to staff and students.

In his talk; **embracing dreams**, Mr. Swami emphasized that it is important for every human being to have a higher goal by having a dream.

**“A dream is not the one that you have when you are asleep, rather, a dream is what makes you not to sleep. You need to be inspired. There is a saying, ‘When you have a real dream, it helps you break barriers of thought’ If you don’t pursue something higher there are many talents that will go to waste”.** Mr.

Swami started of his talk.

Mr. Swami explained that there are 5 major points to consider when embracing dreams:

1. Dare to dream: Keep your dream a little higher. This is by going by what your heart says. One should have daringness to dream.
2. Prepare to dream: Be very sure that it is your dream. A man once went to the tailor but was disappointed because the shoulders were too tight. The tailor told him to walk while bending like someone who is disabled. A man saw him and asked who the wonderful tailor was that made his suit. He was surprised that someone has actually made a suit for the crippled. This shocked him as he wasn't disabled. The lesson here is that we shouldn't fit to others.
3. Live your dream: You have to work much harder than you expect and have faith that you will reach your potential. Don't hold yourself.
4. Repair your dream: This is by keeping yourselves more and more inspired by talking to your seniors. When you prepare your dreams means changing all your habits and forging old habits that derail you or make your dreams drag.
5. Share your dream: Don't let the success limit you. It is important to share with others as well as that's the thing you will be remembered with. For example: we have names we are remembered with that is the name from our parents, the nicknames and the name that you gain through your actions

## **VARSITY HOSTS INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP PASTORALISTS**

On September 27-29, 2022, Lukenya University hosted a Youth Workshop funded by ILRI, IFAD and FAO on Pastoralism. The Workshop provided a platform for the youth pastoralists to learn, share their experiences, discuss the many challenges owing to climate change and as a team, propose solutions to such challenges. The workshop consisted of youth pastoralists from Ethiopia, Tanzania and Kenya. Our very own, Bernard Kimani, presented a post-harvest loss reduction innovation in the workshop.



During the Workshop, it was noted that loss of livestock in the Eastern Africa region as a result of drought and other extreme weather conditions was overwhelming. It was evident that apart from controlling the number of animals that one should rear, it was essential to have resilient animal feed systems.



Water harvesting technologies were equally advocated for as a way to assuring a year-round supply of water. The conference went on to acknowledge that for significant economic benefits from pastoralism to be realized, there was need to devote more effort on improving livestock breeds- to increase productivity, pasture

to ensure sufficiency, and pasture management as a key element of embedding sustainability of pastoralism.
