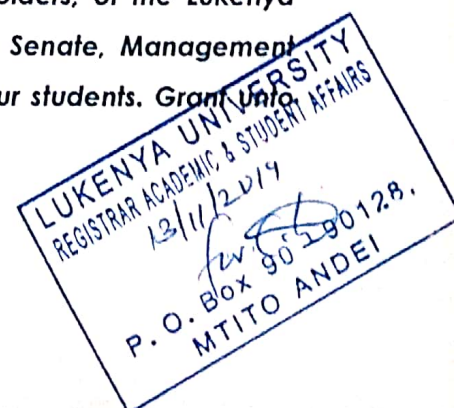

BOT Chair reads a brief biography of the Chancellor

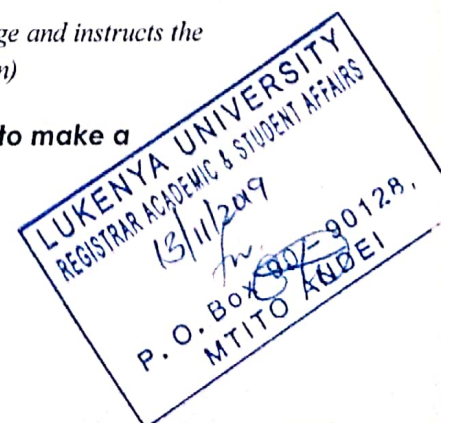
*(The BOT Chair invites Mr. Harris Mule to the podium for gowning and installation)*
